Our **AGM** this year will be on Wednesday 13th March, at 7.30pm, at The Dog and Rot (Conservative Working Men's Club) next door to the mill. Please do come along if you can. The meeting is quite short, and it is a chance to catch up with other members, and have a drink and a chat.

Last year I reported that we were trying to fix the problem of water in the pit below the pit wheel, using new technology involving injecting a 'geopolymer' into the mill floor to form an impermeable barrier. This is proving to be more difficult and prolonged than we had hoped. Historic England have been helpful, the local council less so! We are awaiting further specialist advice, and will need to review whether the project is still worthwhile.
